ECO LINE****SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES****4.1 Description of first aid measures:**

The symptoms resulting from intoxication can appear after exposure, therefore, in case of doubt, seek medical attention for direct exposure to the chemical product or persistent discomfort, showing the SDS of this product.

By inhalation:

This product does not contain substances classified as hazardous for inhalation, however, in case of symptoms of intoxication remove the person affected from the exposure area and provide with fresh air. Seek medical attention if the symptoms get worse or persist.

By skin contact:

This product is not classified as hazardous when in contact with the skin. SECTION 5: FIREFIGHTING MEASURES**5.1 Extinguishing media:**

Product is non-flammable under normal conditions of storage, manipulation and use.
